<p><b>To encourage new community events, the Health District will charge 50% of the established fees for each vendor for a first-time event. (Health District will determine if the event is a new event)</b></p> <p><b>For vendors that have a licensed base of operations and want to participate in multiple temporary events in the community, the Health District will charge an annual fee of \$300. The vendors would be reviewed one time and would need to maintain the same menu and could receive multiple temporary food licensed throughout the year. We will create a list of these vendors to facilitate event coordinators in planning their events.</b></p>	
<b>Farmer's Markets</b> 1) Sale of whole, uncut produce or fruits by farm/farmer 2) Seasonal Permit Fee for Sampling @ Farmers Market – a) April to October of 180 consecutive days (season): Farm/farm produced/farm processed food or beverage items. No Charge Commercial vendor/approved licensed food or beverage item. \$25.00 3) Seasonal Permit Fee for sale of individual portions of foods or Beverages at Farmers Market \$100/season a) April to October or 180 consecutive days (season) Commercial vendor/approved licensed food or beverage items \$50.00 b) 90 consecutive days or less as part of season for commercial vendor c) One day market event (per commercial vendor) <b>Any vendor who would like to have one trial day at a market, may do so at no charge. The application must be submitted in the timeframe required. If the vendor chooses to participate after the trial day, they must submit the full fee prior to the next market date in order to do so. This will encourage new vendors to participate in our market</b> No Charge d) Farmer/farm selling food or beverage products (from an approved source) in individual portions (per farmer or farm) \$25.00/Season  4) Guest Chef Demonstration per individual market date: \$25.00 Guest Chef demonstrations are to comply with Section 19-13-B42 of the CT PHC for Temporary Food Service Establishments and requirements for sampling at the market. Application for Guest chef shall be submitted at least 14 days prior to event date  5) Late Fee: Submittal of an application for a Farmers Market less than 14 days from the state date of sales or sampling at the event. \$25.00
