Scheduling a COVID-19 Vaccination Appointment in VAMS

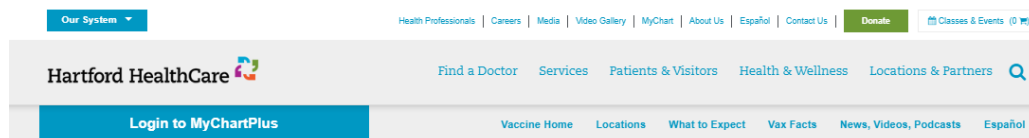
VAMS stands for Vaccine Administration Management System. It is a scheduling tool for COVID-19 vaccine appointments. **You may have been directed to this page because you have selected a vaccination clinic that uses VAMS for scheduling.**

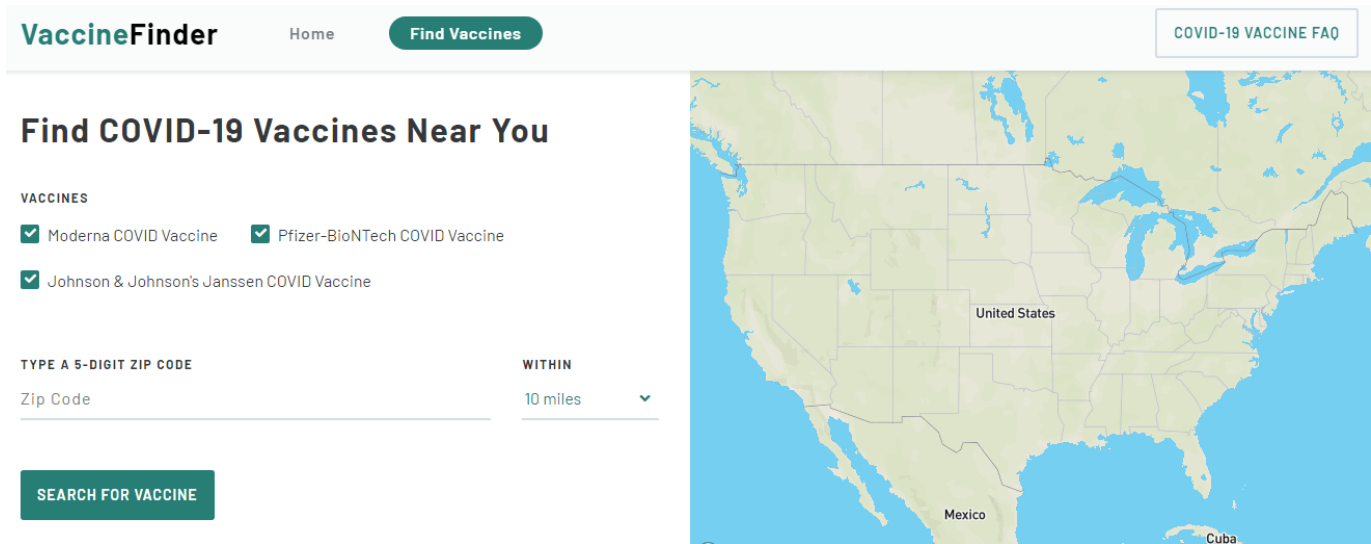

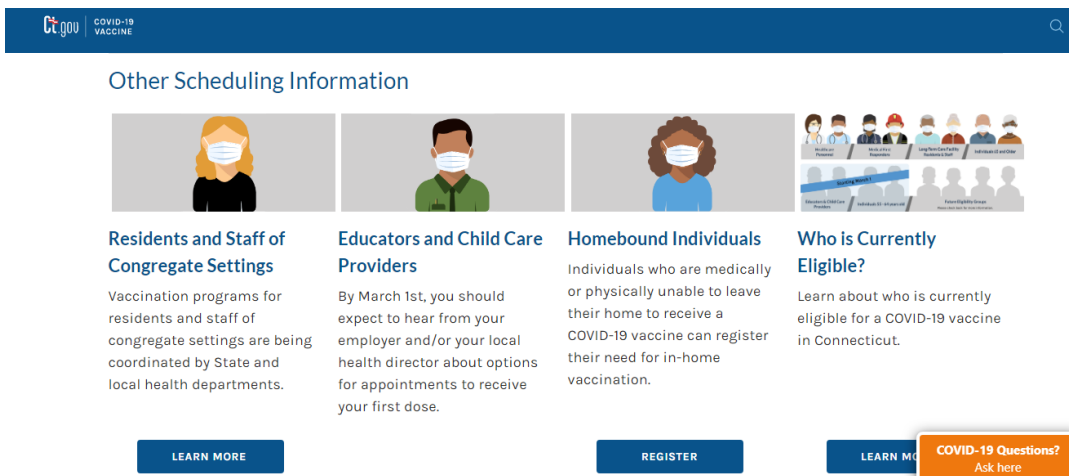
