



PreK-12, Child Care Youth Camp, Birth to Three, And Home Visiting Programs Serving Children Guidance

If you test positive for COVID-19 **Isolate**

Everyone regardless of vaccination status	Stay at home for 5 days
	If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house
	Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days

If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves

If you were exposed to someone with Covid-19 **Quarantine**

A. If you:

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine	Continue with in-person learning
	Test for COVID-19 5 days after exposure
	Consider quarantining for 5 days from other activities outside of school especially if notified of an extended high intensity exposure (Ex: household contact, unmasked social contact, contact during athletic activities)
Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine	Wear a mask around others for 10 days

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home

B. If you:

Are unvaccinated	Stay at home for 5 days from school, extracurricular activities, and other activities from the last exposure
	Test for COVID-19 5 days after the exposure
	Wear a mask at all times during any activities when around others for an additional 5 days
Partially vaccinated	
Vaccination status is unknown	

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home

*Those who are recovered from confirmed COVID-19 in last 90 days do not have to quarantine or test they must mask around others for 10 days.

*Those too young to wear a mask or unable due to a medical exemption must isolate and quarantine for 10 days
