



Flu Vaccination Q & A

Q: I have not attended a North Central District Health Dept (NCDHD) sponsored flu vaccination clinic in the past. Will I be able to get vaccinated at a NCDHD clinic this year?

A: Yes.

Q: I have never received an influenza vaccine, should I get one?

A: Yes, everyone 6 months of age and older should get a flu vaccine every season.

Q: What types of flu vaccine will you have?

A: NCDHD will offer the FluLaval & Flucelvax Quadrivalent vaccine for those ages 4 years and up.

Q: Will you be vaccinating all age groups?

A: No. We will not be vaccinating children under 4 years of age at our clinics. Parents with children under 4 years of age should contact their pediatrician.

Q: When will the Flu vaccine be available?

A: NCDHD anticipates starting vaccinations mid to late September.

Q: Where do I need to reside to pre-register for a flu shot?

A: Anywhere in Connecticut.

Q: Is pre-registration required?

A: Yes.

Q: I want to pre-register, however I may decide to get a vaccination from another source ex. (Physician's office, Pharmacy); Is that OK?

A: Yes. Pre-registration with NCDHD does not commit you to our clinic. Please inform us if you have changed your mind.

Q: Can I fill out one pre-registration consent form for my entire family?

A: No. Each person receiving a vaccination needs their own form.

Q: Do I need my parent or legal guardian to be present when I receive my vaccine?

A: Yes, if you under 18 years old.

Q: May a grandparent, friend, etc. bring me to a vaccination site if my parent or legal guardian is not available and I am under 18 years old?

A: No. A parent or legal guardian must be present.



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Q: What Insurance will NCDHD accept?

A: Aetna
Anthem
Cigna
CTCare
Harvard Pilgrim
Husky

If you have other insurance, you should contact another provider or your primary care office if you are over the age of 18, the fee for the standard dose is \$30.00.

If you do not have insurance and this vaccine is for someone between 4-18 years of age, please contact NCDHD.

No child will be refused if they currently do not have the ability to pay.
