In accordance with State Health Department Regulations developed under Chapter 54 of the Connecticut General Statues, we must be provided with the name, address, and Connecticut License Number of the supervising physician for each tattoo studio. In accordance with the North Central District Health Department Sanitary Code, there is a \$100.00 fee that must be submitted to this office with that information.

Also, you must provide a signed statement from the physician, on his/her letterhead, stating that he/she has trained the technicians. The statement must include original signatures and printed names of each technician at your facility that has been trained to administer the tattooing procedure by the physician. These signatures must be on the same paper that the physician signs.

The above information is required on a yearly basis – every February.
